### THE CARDINAL & THE POPE

NO; this is not an "insider's" view on Vatican 'intrigue' It is however a peek at the pope & one of his Toronto visitors - a peek which came to light thanks to the Toronto archbishop of the 1980's: Gerald Emmett CARD. Carter.

In a magazine item in 1983 His Eminence told of a private conversation which took place between him and Pope (become - saint) John Paul II. The two of them were recovering from serious health concerns: the cardinal from a major stroke/the pope a

near-fatal shooting.

As the cardinal urged the pope to

"take it easy" Pope John Paul II asked,

"What about you?"

And Cardinal Carter then said,

"I'm all right. I've

learned to accept my condition". He was told that, "It is not enough to accept your condition. You must accept it with joy". As he walked away, the cardinal thought to himself; 'JOY; that's the difficult part'.



In the face of problems of all sorts the element of Christian joy is one to reconsider. It is a grace of God with which we can be at peace with the realities of life - a peace, as Our Lord said, "Which the world itself can't give". He prayed for us in regards to it: "That (His) joy may be in (us), and (our) joy be complete"

It is a sense of peace and joy embodied, literally, in the life of the Mother of the Lord + Our Mother. In this month of the Holy Rosary we ask for her help, Mother full of holy joy, pray for us.

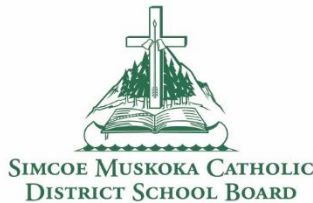

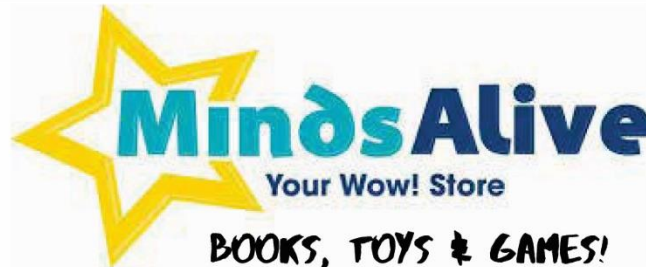
