On the occasion of the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the General Assembly of the United Nations, Pope Francis said, "We never emerge from a crisis just as we were. We come out either better or worse."

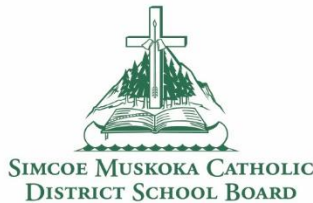

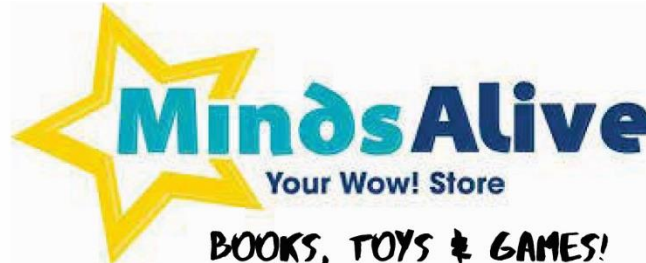
