



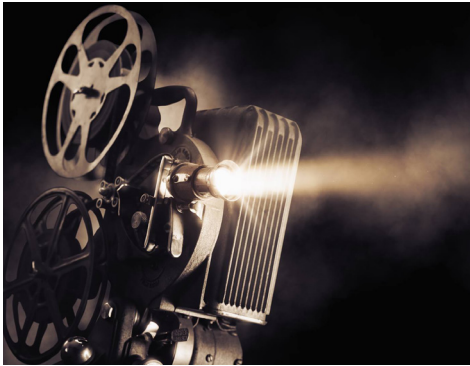

Upcoming Events at Martyrs' Shrine

Over the past few years, we've worked on creating more opportunities for pilgrims to deepen their relationship with Christ by journeying with St. Jean de Brébeuf, and his companions at Martyrs' Shrine.

Two upcoming events are great new additions to our programme offering that are both engaging and spiritually enriching.



Watch & Pray - A Retreat With Movies is an evening series of retreats offered at 6:00 PM every Wednesday in August (7, 14, 21, & 28) led by Fr. George Vallocheril, SJ. During the retreat, participants will be guided in using movies as both a tool for prayer, and a source of spiritual nourishment. Every evening, Fr. George will introduce the movie's topics and give points of reflection so that one can analyse the movie as they watch. Following the screening of the film, a group discussion will enter deeper into the movie's content and act as a jumping-off point to further reflect on the story through prayer. Fr. George Vallocheril, SJ, is a Jesuit priest from the province of Kerala, India. He is a media education scholar and trainer. He has an MA in Sociology from Kerala University, a MA in Journalism, and a PhD in Media Studies from Marquette University, Milwaukee, USA. He is the founder of Thanmaya Media Institute at Kottayam where he served as its first director from 1998 to 2014. He is also Visiting Faculty at Marquette University and a Guest Faculty in a number of colleges, universities and seminaries in India and abroad. Fr. George has conducted hundreds of media and film seminars, workshops and audio-visual retreats in India and other countries.

How Great Thou Art!?! is a 3-Day, 2-Night Plein Air Art Retreat led by our Resident Artist, Mrs Ingrid Vija Brooks. The programme includes daily individualised coaching of painting techniques at a variety of scenic locations throughout the shrine's sacred grounds. Artists will be oriented on the historical significance and value of our National Shrine with a talk by Fr. Michael Knox, SJ DPhil (Oxon), the Director of Martyrs' Shrine.

The plein-air art retreat runs Friday September 20th, Saturday the 21st, and Sunday the 22nd, includes overnight accommodation on-site, and is open to artists of all skill levels.

As you may or may not know, the shrine is run by the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) who were founded by St. Ignatius Loyola. Erik Oland, Provincial of the Jesuits of Canada. If you cannot attend our 12:00 noon Mass, but would like to attend another Mass that day in honour of the Feast Day, all Masses on that day will be dedicated to St. Ignatius Loyola, and his statue displayed prominently in the Sanctuary.
