Les Trois Soeurs Café Re-Opens on a new foundation

At the beginning of our 2018 season, the operator of the Café informed the Jesuit Fathers that they were unable to continue providing food services at Martyrs' Shrine. Since the beginning of the season was too near, it was determined that there would not be enough time to carry-out a proper and fair Request for Proposal (RFP) process in-time for the season.

As the future of the Café was re-evaluated over the course of the 2018 season, a formal RFP was drafted and sent out to a variety of qualified local food service providers in the area. Through this process, Mr. Harold Lucas, a local businessman who also operates a food truck, famous for its venison poutine, named *The Hungry Voyageur*, near the site of St. Ignace II, at the corner of Highway 12 and Rosemount Rd, was selected as the suitable candidate for the renewal and re-opening of the Café.



Various upgrades to the facility were required, and Mr. Lucas and his family invested many long hours into the renewal of the space to ensure it was suitable, and clean for a new era of services to the pilgrims of Martyrs' Shrine.

Mr. Lucas brings with him not only years of experience in the food industry, but also his family of hard workers who each have their own specialty in various sectors. His daughter, Christina, an educator with a passion for healthy clean eating, will be assisting her father with the operation of the Café, and brings a vision of educational programming, and interactive classes to the future of the establishment.

The Café is now officially open for the remainder of the 2019 season, and will offer a menu featuring staples such as hot dogs, French fries, and ice cream along with some more health-conscious pairings. Les Trois Soeurs Café will be open daily from 10:00 am to 4:00 PM. We invite you to visit the renewed space, and sample the new menu.
