
# NOVENA TO ST. JOSEPH

### "O Joseph, assist my labours and give me grace."

- Greek inscription, 4th or 5th century

The Catholic Church dedicates the entire month of March to St. Joseph and urges people of faith to pay special attention to his life and example. Joseph's words are not quoted anywhere in the Bible, but since the time of the early Church, he has been invoked as a powerful intercessor. He was the foster father of Jesus Christ, and the husband of the Virgin Mary. As a carpenter, he is seen as the patron saint of workers, and has also been named patron and protector of the Universal Church. He is called the "terror of demons" because of the effectiveness of his intercession, and is the patron of the sick and of a happy death, since it's believed he died in the presence of Jesus and Mary. Because of his chastity, he is often portrayed with a white lily, and he, along with Mary, are models for the consecrated life, thereby making St. Joseph the patron of both the married and consecrated vocations.

St. Joseph is the patron of Canada, an honour that dates back to the earliest times of French settlement. The consecration of Canada to St. Joseph took place in 1624 by the Recollet missionary Fr. Joseph Le Caron in Quebec. Pope Urban XIII confirmed it in 1637, granting a plenary indulgence to all Canadians who pray to him on the feast-day, March 19. In 1834, the consecration was confirmed by Gregory XVI and St. Joseph officially became the first Patron of Canada.

The Canadian Martyrs had a great love and devotion for St. Joseph, naming their chapel at Sainte-Marie after him. Today the church at Martyrs' Shrine in Midland, Ontario, is called the church of St. Joseph. Outdoors, just above the church, a large statue of St. Joseph, surrounded by a fountain, is a place of great devotion for thousands of pilgrims.

Following the pattern of the Apostles and the Virgin Mary and other women, who gathered in the upper room and "devoted themselves to prayer" for the nine days between the Ascension and Pentecost (Acts 1:14), Christians have prayed novenas. A private or public devotion for nine successive days, a novena is considered a special means of accessing the grace of God through the communion of saints. The St. Joseph Novena is rightly considered among the most powerful of novenas.

### **DAY ONE**

V. Magnify the Lord with me; R. and let us exalt his name together.

Blessed Joseph, to us too, show yourself a father and guide us in the path of life. Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage, and defend us from every evil.

O Foster-father of the Son of God, obtain for us through your divine Son the grace of obedience to the will of the Father. Amen.

Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be.

Blessed Joseph, to us too, show yourself a father and guide us in the path of life. Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage, and defend us from every evil.

O Watchful Defender of Christ, obtain for us through your divine Son the grace of adoration. Amen.

Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be.

# LITANY TO ST. JOSEPH

In the Litany of Saint Joseph, the Church invokes the most chaste Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the foster father and Guardian of the Redeemer, and patron saint of the Universal Church. In May 2021, in honour of the Year of Saint Joseph, Pope Francis added seven new invocations to the litany. All for Jesus, all through Mary, all after thine example, O Patriarch St. Joseph. Such shall be my motto in life and in death.

And even as of old you did rescue the Child Jesus from the peril of His life, so now defend God's Holy Church from the snares of the enemy and from all adversity. Shield us ever under your patronage, that, following your example and strengthened by your help, we may live a holy life, die a happy death, and attain to everlasting happiness in heaven. Amen.
