Most Holy Trinity

One of the most difficult concepts to understand, is the concept of The 'Most Holy Trinity' or of the Trinitarian 'Three Gods in One' idea and belief. The Trinitarian concept of the Most Divine Majesty, as pondered by St. Ignatius of Loyola, and by many other saints and philosophers, was rather difficult to put into simple words for the human mind to grasp and understand.
