WEEKLY REFLECTION

Corpus Christi

There is a very fine hymn, named *Abide with me*. The hymn singer is asking God to stay with, to be present to him or her. We do not use the word *abide* in ordinary speech, but in the Gospel of St. John, Jesus used this word thirty times. Jesus speaking of abiding with His Heavenly Father, He speaks of abiding with His disciples, and He invites His disciples to abide with Him.

In John 14:18 Jesus tells His disciples that He will not leave them orphans. In John 14:3 the Greek word used in the original, implies an active, ongoing, protective presence. This presence is clearly expressed in the ancient Irish hymn, "Christ beside me, Christ before me, Christ behind me, King of my heart. Christ be within me, Christ be below me, Christ be above me, never to part."

Today, we ask to be ever more grateful for Christi's Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist. We ask that He strengthen our faith in Him, our hope in Him, and our charity. We ask that He really and truly abide with us.
