WEEKLY REFLECTION

Wisdom & the Teachings of Christ

I am the living bread that came down from Heaven' said Jesus to the crowds that followed Him after feeding the more than 5K hungry & thirsty crowds that sought him thinking that they would be fed fish and bread for the rest of their lives. They were in for a rude shock when He told them not to rely on material food, that would enslave them like pets and cattle but on spiritual food that came from the mouth of God. He wanted to treat them with Human Dignity, to earn their daily bread with honest work and the talents gifted to them by their creator.

When Jesus told them that they had to eat His flesh and drink His blood, it made perfect sense for them at that time and era. As yet, there was no holy communion for them in those days, but when they offered animal sacrifices, the priest would retain some choice part of the burnt offering for themselves, and give the rest to the family for sharing it with their family and friends. When they partook of this meal, they believed they were ingesting God who had come into the sacrifice, and to them, this was the Holy Communion which we now have today. But more important than this is, what Jesus finally told them, what Isiah had said long time back, and what Jesus quoted to Satan in the temptation in the dessert. 'Man should not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God'.

In other words, Jesus plainly told them that the words He spoke are Spirit Filled Life Giving Eternal Words. Those who live by it, will never lose hope, and those who hope will live in eternity. We ought to bring ourselves to live on the teachings of Jesus, which we teach our little children to have a bright future by never losing hope in life, and not to be led astray by shallow living, and enslavement by the many attractions this lovely world can prevent them from glorifying God by their lives.
